



Cookie Policy

1. Purpose

This Cookie Policy explains how GT Sales Progression (“GT”, “we”, “our” or “us”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our website.

By continuing to use our website, you agree to the use of cookies in accordance with this policy, unless you choose to disable them through your browser settings or cookie preferences.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, improve user experience and provide information about how the website is used.

Cookies may be set by us directly (“first-party cookies”) or by third-party providers (“third-party cookies”).

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of our website. They enable core functions such as page navigation, security, access to secure areas and form submissions. Without these cookies, the website may not function correctly.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website by collecting anonymous information such as:

- Number of visitors
- Pages viewed
- Time spent on the website
- Traffic sources
- Errors or performance issues

This information helps us improve the website and user experience.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make, such as your location, preferences or saved settings, to provide a more personalised experience.

Third-Party Cookies

Some parts of our website may use services provided by third parties, such as:

- Google Analytics
- Embedded maps
- Social media links
- Video content
- Website hosting or security tools

These third parties may place cookies on your device in accordance with their own privacy and cookie policies.

4. How We Use Cookies

GT Sales Progression uses cookies to:

- Ensure the website operates correctly
- Improve website performance and functionality
- Understand how visitors use the website
- Monitor website traffic and trends
- Support website security
- Remember user preferences

We do not use cookies to collect sensitive personal information.
